Leaf Exchange Program - Jackson County Air Quality: The Leaf Exchange Program gives residents an alternative to burning leaves, which contributes to particulate matter and other pollutants in the air. Jackson County Air Quality compiles a contact list of people who have leaves to dispose of, and another list of those who are looking for leaves to make compost. Leaf donors and leaf recipients can then contact each other to arrange for pick up and delivery of the leaves. To add your name to the list, contact Jackson County Environmental Public Health, 541.774.8206, press 5 for front office staff.

Recology Ashland Free Leaf Drop-off Days: Sundays, Nov 6 and Dec 11 only, 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Recology Ashland will accept leaves for free drop-off at the recycling center, 220 Water Street. Plastic bags will need to be emptied and taken away. Branches and other yard debris are not accepted. 541.482.1471

Rogue Disposal Transfer Station Free Leaf Drop-off: 8001 Table Rock Road, drop-off leaves and other green waste free of charge. Bags, cans and other receptacles must be emptied in the designated area; do not mix them with green waste. Hours: M-F 8am-4pm, Sat 7am-4pm, closed Sunday, year-round. Cities of Ashland & Talent Pre-paid Leaf Bag Program: Oct 24-Nov 4 residents of Ashland and Talent may purchase 5 pre-paid bags for a discounted price of \$10.00 (regularly \$14.50) at the Recology Ashland office, 170 Oak Street. There is a 2 package limit. Talent residents may also purchase discounted bags at the Talent City Hall, 110 E. Main St., Talent. Leaves only; branches and other yard debris are not accepted. On trash collection day, during a green debris/recycle week, place bags at the curb. Unused bags may be used anytime throughout the year. There is a 35 lb. limit on bags. 541.482.1471

City of Central Point Leaf Pick-up: Monday, Nov 21 and Friday, Dec 16 only; collection by Rogue Disposal. Bagged leaves only; bags with branches or any other debris will not be collected. Bags must weigh less than 40 lbs. and should be tied closed. Place bags in the public right of way the night before or early in the morning the day of leaf pick up. It is against City ordinance to blow leaves into the street, as it clogs storm drains. 541.664.3321, ext. 241

City of Eagle Point Annual leaf Pick-up: Nov 14-Dec 16, within Eagle Point city limits only. Bagged leaves only; bags with branches or any other debris will not be collected. Bags must weigh less than 40 lbs. All bags should be placed behind the curb for pickup. No collections will be done on private property. Do not place bags in the street. The City cannot specify the exact date leaves will be picked up; do not telephone the City for collection. Anyone wishing bagged leaves for mulch may request them by phoning the Public Works shop at 541.826.4212 ext. 138, or pick them up curbside on any street.

City of Medford Leaf Collection: Nov 7-Dec 30. Anyone within Medford city limits is eligible for leaf pickup by Rogue Disposal & Recycling at no charge. Place leaves in 33 gallon heavy-duty plastic bags, tie them shut and put them at the curb (if you don't have a curb, place bags off the roadway, approximately 8 ft. from the pavement). Every few weeks, a crew will be by to pick up the bags, though it will not necessarily occur on your regular trash day. Bags with branches and other debris will not be collected. Bags must not weigh more than 40 lbs. Medford residents who wish to participate in the collection program must provide their own bags. 541.779.4161 or www.roguedisposal.com

City of Phoenix Leaf Collection Day: Mon Dec 12 only; collection by Rogue Disposal. Bagged leaves only; bags with branches and other debris will not be collected. Bags must not weigh more than 40 lbs. and be tied shut. Place bags at the curb by 7:00 a.m. For more information call Theresa at Phoenix Public Works, 541.535.2226

City of Rogue River Annual Leaf Pick-up: Oct 24-Jan 27, within Rogue River city limits only. Bag or pile your leaves for collection. Piles need to be within the reach of a 6-foot vacuum hose, but not behind fences, in the gutters, or the street. Bags should be in a driveway or in the front yard, not blocking the sidewalk. After leaves have been placed, call City Hall at 541.582.4401. Leaves only; no grass, branches, rocks, etc. if any items other than leaves are included, the pile or bags will not be collected.

Compost in Your Own Backyard: Year-round. Composting is easy, inexpensive and fun. Watch your leaves and grass clippings become a useful soil amendment for your garden, lawn or houseplants.
